Meeting Minutes ENCORE Curriculum Committee

John R. wants to explore with Larry Miller the mounting of a rail with distributable hooks for suspending maps and other teaching aids. John will report back in March.

New Business:

- 1. John Ryan reminded the members of the Senior Center's open house on February 16.
- 2. Spring term runs from 3/28 to 5/20/16. The class schedule still has some gaps. Erhard is to contact the city for use of the council chamber on Thursday afternoons for his class.
- 3. There was consensus on using the same budget figures for the next fiscal year as for the current one.
- 4. Reta reminded the members that today is the final date for submission of material for the newsletter.
