Meeting Minutes ENCORE Curriculum Committee

May 8, 2017 Astoria Senior Center

Old Business:

- 3. Reta asked Frank to allow mention of the fall term trip and the Dr. Borg's program (below) at the Annual Membership meeting.
- 4. The AARP driving class scheduled for May 9 was deferred to a future date.

New Business:

- 1. Reta reported that the fall 2017 class schedule is evolving slowly. (Erhard is prepared to submit his course proposal for the one-day course on Forest Tree Identification, which is scheduled for October 2 and will run from 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM.)
- 2. Erhard announced details of Dr. Scott Borg's presentation on Antarctica. It will take place at 6:00 PM, August 17, in the Senior Center. The topics range from "the Antarctic with a bit of history, a bit on geopolitics (e.g. the Antarctic Treaty), and a brief introduction to the US Antarctic Program and the kinds of science that we support."

Erhard requested that the Board be approached for picking up the cost of the dinner for Dr. Borg, his wife and his mother. The program is open to the public and will be broadly advertised.
