- 2. She also passed out the early class plans for those two terms.
 - a) Seth will teach philosophy during the Winter term.
 - b) Evy will teach Needle Craft.
 - c) Bernie is considering repeating her popular Decades course.
 - d) Rick may be joined for Science Exchange by Kit Ketcham.
 - e) Because of the complexity of scouting venues, planning and securing contacts, Erhard was encouraged to make preliminary announcements to the membership re his course Justice and Violence: Broken Treaties and Promises and its field trip. (Revised class meeting dates are April 21, 28, May 5, 12 and 19. A field trip to the Nez Perce and the Umatilla Indian reservations is scheduled for May 23-25.) He was authorized to use the assistance of two coordinators (Elfi Gross and Rose Power).
 - f) Several committee members mentioned the desirability of a course by Master Gardeners.
